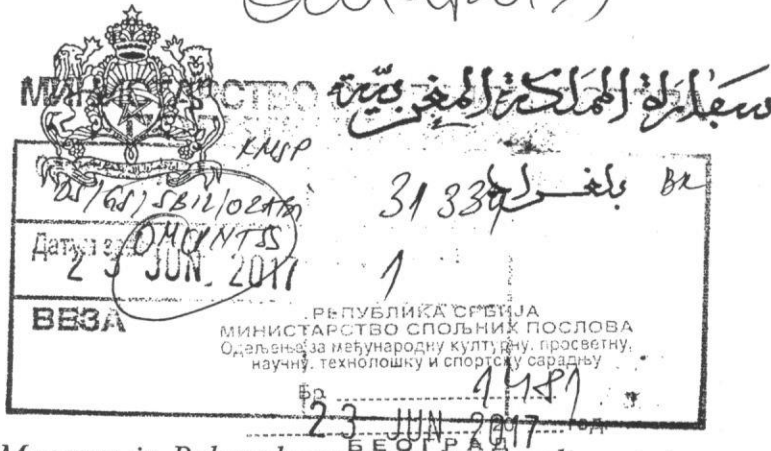

*The Embassy of the Kingdom of Morocco in Belgrade presents its compliments to the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the Republic of Serbia - International Cultural, Educational, Scientific, Technological and Sports Cooperation Department-, and has the honor to inform that the Moroccan Agency for International Cooperation (AMCI) offers the Republic of Serbia a quota of 15 scholarships for Serbian students who wish to study at one of the Moroccan public higher education, technical or vocational institutions for the academic year 2017/2018.*

*Since French is the language used in scientific, technical and economic studies, applicants to these branches who don't master the French language will have to attend French language upgrading courses at the Agency's International languages Center.*

*The Embassy of the Kingdom of Morocco in Belgrade would also like to inform the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Serbia that **the deadlines for receipt of applications by the AMCI are 15 August 2017 for Categories A and B, and 15 November 2017 for category C**, given that the calendar established by the Department of Higher Education for the start of the 2017/2018 academic year is as follows:*

*Category A (Regulated access): 1st week of September 2017*

*Category B: (Open access): Mid-September 2017*

*Category C (Upgrade courses in French): January 1<sup>st</sup>, 2018.*

*Candidates selected for studying in Morocco are invited, upon arrival at AMCI, to be in possession of a long stay visa (student visa) and to provide a certificate proving*

that they are vaccinated against infectious and contagious diseases, including tuberculosis.
